- II. Roll call was taken: Whitlow Wertz – P, Randy Eddinger – P, Gary Yocum Sr.– P, Debra Stine-P and Curt Robbins -P. Also, present were Water Coordinator Donna Miller, Attorney Scott Williams; Attorney Zach DuGan; Engineer Shawn Downey; Ruth Little; Steve Cook and Johnny Lynch Jr from WBRA.

Donna Miller reported on the following:

VIII. New Business:

1. Engineer's Report. Engineer Shawn Downey reviewed the report as follows:

LSA Grant Phase I Broad St/Wagner Ave-A preconstruction meeting was held on May 13th; Contractor plans to start early June. The water line on Wagner/5th Street had to be move slightly due to the sewer location; updated plans will be given to the Contractor

LSA Grant Phase II Broad St/Wagner Ave– Working on design; anticipated for a 2027 construction project

SRBC-Leak Detection Grant Remaining balance is \$6,222.76 with a deadline of June 30, 2027.

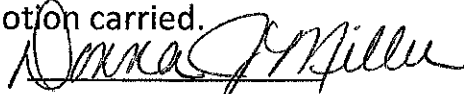
New Well-#5 Design and permit applications are being prepared; anticipating a DEP permit submission in June; anticipated completion is September 2028; with a preliminary budget of \$2,585,000.00

Deb Stine and Johnny Lynch Jr talked about the hook up to sewer for Well #5; the cost would be roughly \$6000 for hook up; \$6000 for construction and materials and a monthly charge of \$280.00; WBRA proposed that if WBRA receives free water they would wave these fees; after a discussion Randy Eddinger; Whitlow Wertz; Curt Robbins and Gary Yocum stated they pay their fee the Authority will pay our fee-no free water due to the situation the Authority is having with MASD; Deb Stine disagreed.
